Calling all budding bakers! Here's the first of the virtual House Charity Events, the Radnor House FUNdraising Bake-Off.

What is the baking challenge?

To create a Rainbow themed cake OR any type of cake that celebrates the fantastic work being done by ALL KEY WORKERS during the Covid-19 crisis (we are aware not everyone will be able to find enough food colouring for a rainbow). You can decorate the cake however you wish, but do include the message #InThisTogether or #ThankYouKeyWorkers

Why should I take part?

It's FUN more than anything and so many of us are baking at the moment, why not have a House Bake Off and raise charity money at the same time. Anyone can enter a cake into the competition with a suggested donation of £1-£5 to your House Charity.

There will be 5 House points awarded for each entry and prizes/House points for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place.

When is the Bake Off?

If you would like to enter, here's what you need to do:

- The Bake Off will start at 2pm on Wednesday 13 May when you get the call in your House channel of Ready, Steady, Bake!
- Bake your cake using whatever ingredients you choose and take pictures/video clips of the process (just for fun).
- Please submit your final Bake Off cake by 3pm on Friday 15 May in the form of final pictures/short video which should include a 'cake cutting and tasting moment.' The taster could be you or another lucky family member.
- Heads of House will judge their own House entries and put forward their top 3 to the final judges - Mrs Pettitt, Mr Penlington and Mr Halliwell.
- Please NOTE- the final judging will not take place until Monday 18 May. If you would like to enter, but cannot bake until the weekend, please let your Head of House know you will be submitting an entry by Monday-9am.

When will the results be announced?
